

Laboratory Safety Agreement

Science laboratories can be hazardous environments. By signing this agreement, I affirm that I understand and will follow all safety rules and procedures provided by my instructor. I understand that violating safety guidelines may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the laboratory and possible academic consequences

General Rules

- Read lab instructions and safety info before starting.
- No horseplay, pranks, or distracting behavior.
- Follow all verbal and written directions.
- Never work unsupervised or perform unauthorized experiments.
- No eating, drinking, or chewing gum in the lab.
- Keep aisles clear and work areas tidy.
- Keep hands away from face, eyes, mouth, and body during lab work.
- Do not sit on lab tables or counters.

Personal Safety

- Always wear approved eye protection.
- Use aprons, gloves, and other PPE as required.
- Wear closed-toe shoes; tie back long hair.
- Report all accidents, spills, breakages, or injuries—no matter how minor—to the instructor immediately.
- Know the location and use of safety equipment.
- Wash hands after lab work.

Laboratory Safety

- Treat all chemicals and specimens as hazardous.
- Read all labels carefully before use.
- Do not remove lab materials from the room.
- Use burners and heat sources with care; turn off when done.
- Do not touch broken glass—use tools to clean up.
- Dispose of materials only as directed.
- Do not pour chemicals back into original containers.
- Do not place hot glassware directly on lab surfaces.
- Label all containers clearly before use.
